The development of a rehabilitation system based on a capable network is the most optimal way to fully solve the problem of access to rehabilitation care.

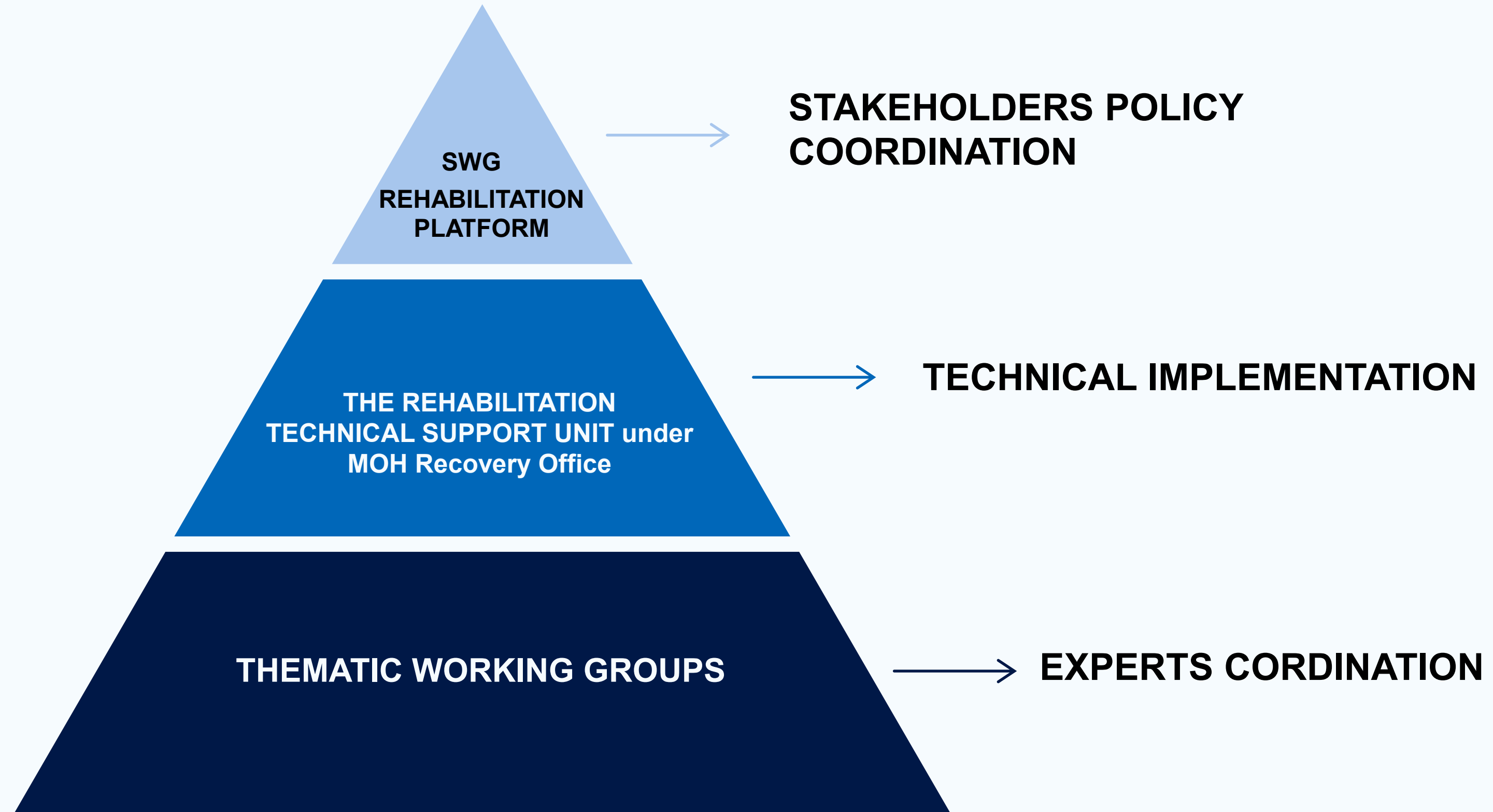


The need to bring all stakeholders under one plan and platform to coordinate this landscape in the most efficient and effective way is urgent.

The Forum will coordinate different stakeholders in the rehabilitation sector involving participants from key ministries, civil society and international partners.

The key functions are to analyse the needs, gaps and priorities for the rehabilitation sector in Ukraine and subsequently guide partners in strategic decision-making.

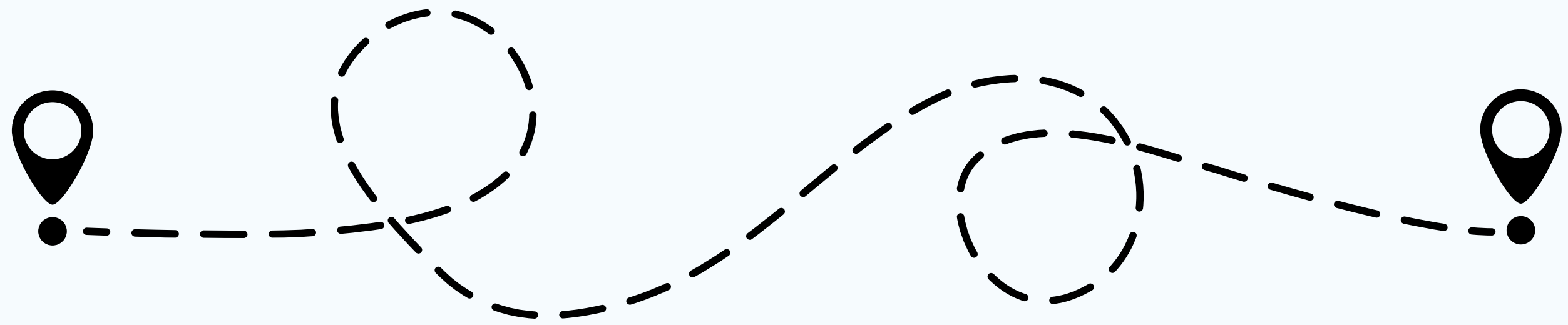

(TIER 1)

EXAMPLES OF DELIVERABLES CAN INCLUDE REHABILITATION TECHNICAL PROTOCOLS, GUIDELINES, AND PILOTING OF SAME; WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES SUCH AS UNIVERSITY LEVEL TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT, ETC.

Briefing their organizations on the orientation, recommendations, and decisions of the Rehabilitation Forum and ensuring that appropriate information-sharing mechanisms in their own agency enable communication of information back to the group

Effectively coordinating their programs and activities, avoiding duplication and overlapping, and working towards good practice standards within their organizations

3

Actively contributing experiences, perspectives, and inputs to the group and proactively assuming responsibilities in tasks and initiatives

4

Serving as advocates in representing the Rehabilitation Forum perspectives when participating in inter-agency and inter-sectorial activities
