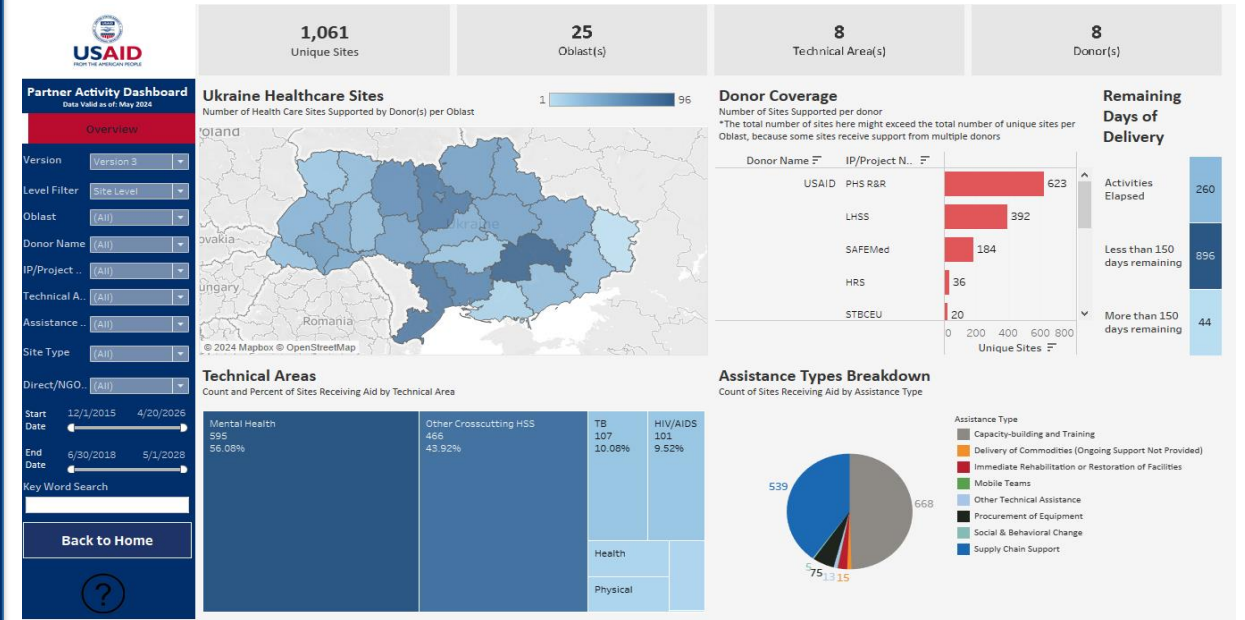

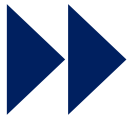


Online Modality

The Partner Activity Dashboards are **now hosted online!** This allows for:



Enhanced Security: The platform will ensure a heightened level of security to safeguard sensitive information. This platform should only be accessible to those granted access.



Version Control: The platform will prioritize easy access and a user-friendly interface to ensure the MOH and participating partners can view the most recent data without any hindrances.



User-Friendly: The platform will allow users to access the Dashboards without the need to download external applications.

Key Metrics for Round 3 of Data Collection



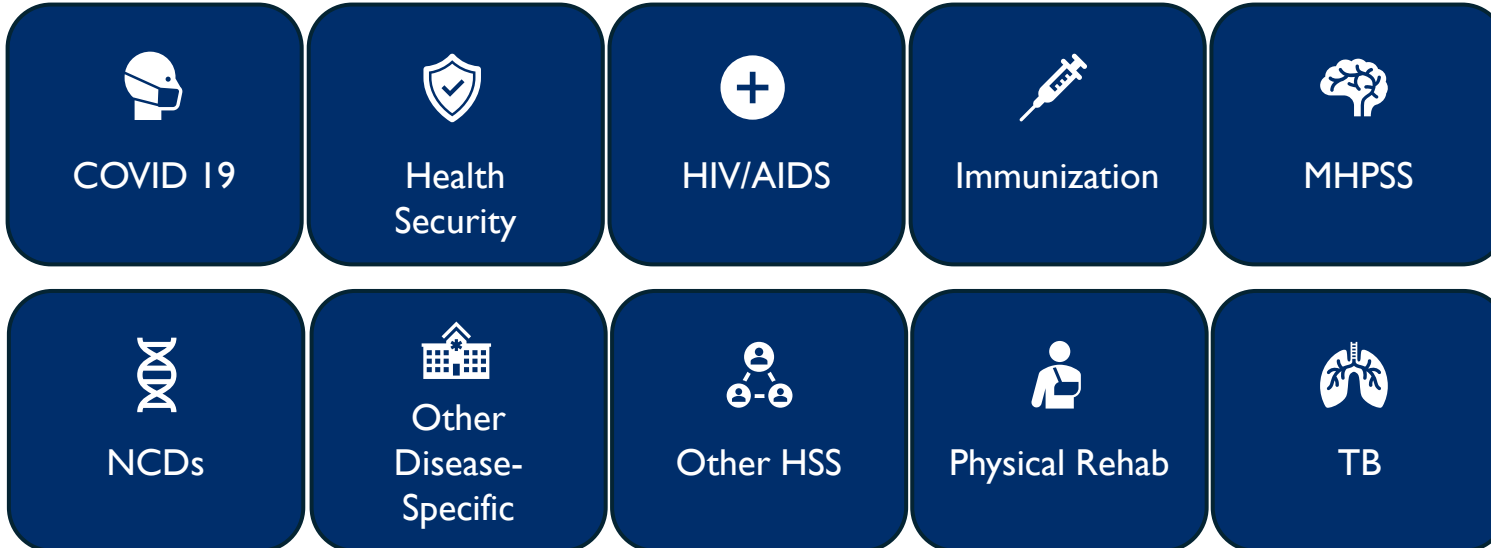

How to Access the Dashboards Online:

The online platform will be **account based**.

Users can access the dashboards in four steps.

Steps to create an account*:

1. Email RPO if you'd like to access the Dashboards.
2. Set up a Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) account with username and password.
3. Access the Dashboards using the link provided by RPO.
4. Reach out to RPO for support as needed.

Instructions for Accessing Dashboards

I. **Set up an Account**

Please email the RPO (recoveryoffice@moz.gov.ua) and copy Rose McGovern (romcgovern@deloitte.com) to request access.

1. After we add your contact information to the portal, you will receive an email to activate your account.
 - a. This will come from **noreply-logon@deloitte.com** and will be titled **“Your account needs to be activated.”**
2. Click the “activate your account” link within this email.
3. Create a password for your account.
 - a. You will need to enter the password twice to validate it.
4. Select your default language for the portal.
5. Select how to configure your Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)
 - a. There are two options:
 - i. **Authenticator app** – You will download a free app to your mobile device, scan the QR code displayed on the screen, then enter the MFA code to set up the app. You will need to open the app and enter the MFA code each time to access the Dashboards.
 - ii. **Mobile phone (recommended)** – You enter your phone number and select if you would like to receive the MFA code via text message (SMS) or phone call. You will then receive the code and enter the MFA code to set up the mobile phone. You will need to receive a text/phone call and enter the MFA code each time to access the Dashboards.
6. Click the “complete” button once MFA is verified.
7. You should see an “activation successful” message on a new page.
 - a. You have now set up your account. Steps 1-7 will not need to be repeated.

I. **Access the Dashboards**

1. Once you have activated your account successfully, the RPO will send you a link to access the dashboards.
2. After you click on the link, please enter the username and password credentials you created above to log-in.
3. You should now have access to the Dashboards.
