ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL COMMITMENT PLAN

- 1. Ukraine (the "Recipient") will implement the Investment Project Financing Component of the TRANSFORMING HEALTHCARE THROUGH REFORM AND INVESTMENTS IN EFFICIENCY Operation (P506083) (the "Project") with the involvement of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine as set out in the Grant Agreement (the "Agreement"). The International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association acting as the administrator of the Ukraine Relief, Recovery, Reconstruction and Reform Multi-Donor Trust Fund (hereinafter the "Bank") has agreed to provide the financing for the Project, as set out in the referred agreement.
- 2. The Recipient shall ensure that the Project is carried out in accordance with the Environmental and Social Standards (ESSs) and this Environmental and Social Commitment Plan (ESCP), in a manner acceptable to the Bank. The ESCP is a part of the Grant Agreement. Unless otherwise defined in this ESCP, capitalized terms used in this ESCP have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement.
- 3. Without limitation to the foregoing, this ESCP sets out material measures and actions that the Recipient shall carry out or cause to be carried out, including, as applicable, the timeframes of the actions and measures, institutional, staffing, training, monitoring and reporting arrangements, and grievance management. The ESCP also sets out the environmental and social (E&S) instruments that shall be adopted and implemented under the Project, all of which shall be subject to prior consultation and disclosure, consistent with the ESSs, and in form and substance, and in a manner acceptable to the Bank. Said E&S documents may be revised from time to time with prior written agreement by the Bank. As provided for under the referred Agreement, the Recipient shall ensure that there are sufficient funds available to cover the costs of implementing the ESCP.
- 4. As agreed by the Bank and the Recipient, this ESCP may be revised from time to time during Project implementation, to reflect adaptive management of Project changes and unforeseen circumstances or in response to assessment of Project performance conducted under the ESCP itself. In such circumstances, the Bank and the Recipient agree to update the ESCP to reflect these changes. Agreement on changes to the ESCP shall be documented through an exchange of letters signed between the Bank and the Recipient. The Recipient shall promptly disclose the updated ESCP.
- 5. The subsection on "Indicators for Implementation Readiness" below identifies the actions and measures to be monitored to assess Project readiness to begin implementation in accordance with this ESCP. Nevertheless, all actions and measures in this ESCP shall be implemented as set out in the "Timeframe" column below irrespective of whether they are listed in the referred subsection.
